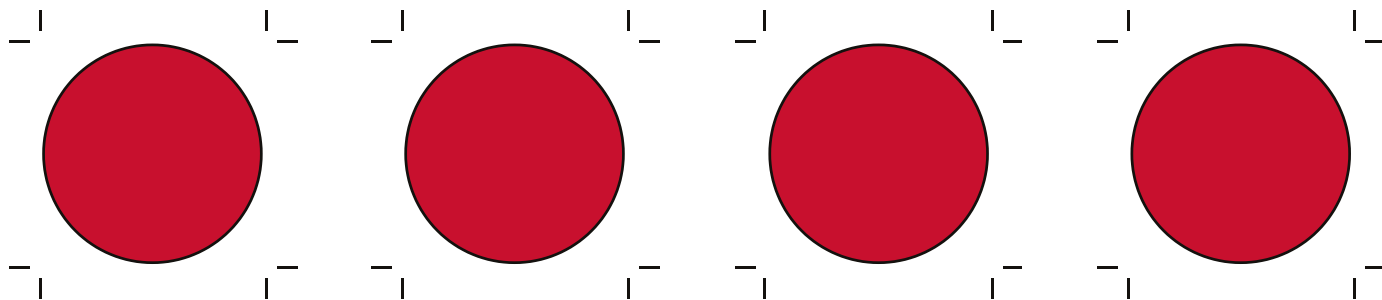


Twelve tokens. A4 portrait, 300 gsm, colour. Print at **100%**. **Laminate the whole sheet first, then cut the shapes out** — people always get this the wrong way round, and cut-first peels within a week. Cut around each shape itself, not around the corner ticks.

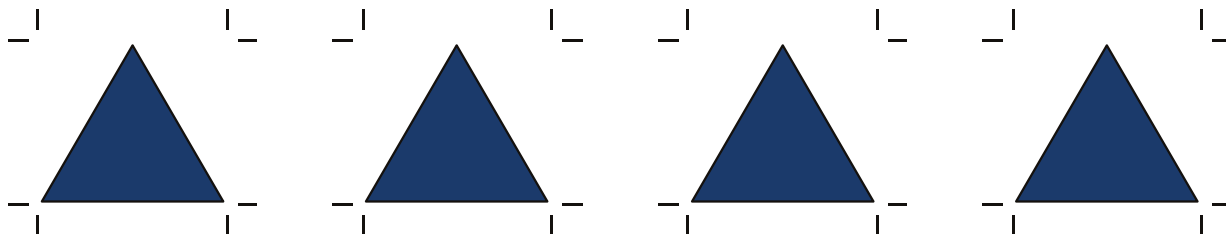
naming word • black triangle • 35 mm base • four



doing word • red circle • 30 mm • four



describing word • dark-blue triangle • 25 mm base • four



Four of each covers any four-word sentence twice over. The colours are the Montessori ones and are not negotiable: shape and colour code the same fact twice, so a colour-blind child still has the shape.

The red circle is 30 mm. The full stop on the Tray 5 punctuation tile is a 10 mm dot. Same shape, same hand, same term — the size is what keeps them apart.
